*Carefully cross the road and go right along Shop Lane. Turn left up Bolts Close.*

14. Only two possible places where the last ship's biscuit can be found. Don't be confused there are three suitable names in this tiny road but only this wonderful one is on your list, so when you discover it cross it off. Although it was perfect, the Jammie Dodger did not stop there.

**You now know where the ship's biscuits are hidden.**

Now might be a good time for your own biscuit; so turn right by Storm Cottage along the footpath and out onto Staithe Street, where you will be spoiled for choice.... and not a weevil in sight.

1. This is a harbour and a port but they are not on your list. Look for the road sign that will tell you another name for this busy place. The Jammie Dodger didn't moor here so you can cross this location off your list.

*Head away from town along Freeman Street.*

2. Just before Blackhorse Yard you should find a cottage belonging to one of the suspects. It wasn't him; he was too busy learning to spell his name, so you can cross him off.

*Continue along then turn left into Dogger Lane*

3. You need to look up and back for this one. Not sure if he was having an argument or just doing his job but you can cross him off your suspect list.

*Turn left at the top of Dogger Lane on to Theatre Road*

4. On the right side you will find where another suspect lives. He was too busy polishing the glass so he didn't do it, and you can cross him off.

*Keep going along Theatre Road then turn left into Red Lion Yard*

5. Not sure where he lives but you can see where he parks his car. He is not guilty so can be crossed off.

*A quick hello to the sea, turn right and maybe pop in for fish and chips, then turn right again up Jicklings Yard*

6. You will need to go almost to the top on the right hand side to find a safe place for a sailing ship, however the Jammie Dodger did not visit on this voyage, so you can cross this location off your list.

*Straight over along Newgate Lane*

7. Although this looks like a good spot for The Jammie Dodger to stop for a while, it's a bit small and not on the water, so you can cross it off.

*Carefully cross the road to The Buttlands and walk along The Globe side.*

8. According to our town sign Wells next the Sea is a safe one of these, but the Jammie Dodger did not stop here, so cross it off.

*Take the narrow passageway down the left hand side of The Crown and follow it all the way to the end.*

9. You will need to look around the cluster of houses on the left. The Jammie Dodger does need to call here from time to time but she didn't get her rigging fixed on this voyage. So cross this location off your list

*Go straight over*

10. You are now on the soggy side of town. History shows lots of ships did come this way at one time but our Jammie Dodger did not stay here so you can cross this off. Remember to say hello to the alpacas!

*At the end turn left and dance your way along Polka Road to the pedestrian crossing. Cross the road and turn next right onto Northfield Lane.*

11. Just the people to steal the biscuit live here, but although they have a reputation for taking and hiding things it wasn't them that stole the biscuit this time.

*Turn into this very happy yard and dance the hornpipe down to the end.*
